

Notice! This page describes the *nature of the error* using a hypothetical example and not the erroneous data of the input test file. You should however be able to apply this information to your error case.



## General description of the error:

**cvc-complex-type.2.4.b:** The content of element "{0}" is not complete. One of "{1}" is expected.

**Error description in schema standard:** <http://www.w3.org/TR/2007/WD-xmlsche...c-complex-type>

## **Possible causes for this error:**

- Child elements are missing from the element

**Error message:** *Error cvc-complex-type.2.4.b: The content of element 'Id' is not complete. One of '{"urn:iso:std:iso:20022:tech:xsd:pain.001.001.03":OrgId, "urn:iso:std:iso:20022:tech:xsd:pain.001.001.03":PrvtId}' is expected.*

**How to fix:** This issue can be fixed by using one of the elements suggested by the error message. Further information can be found from the schema defining the message.
