

Notice! This page describes the *nature of the error* using a hypothetical example and not the erroneous data of the input test file. You should however be able to apply this information to your error case.



General description of the error:

The format of the error message: cvc-complex-type.4: Attribute "{1}" must appear on element "{0}".

Possible causes for this error:

- Element must have an attribute and the attribute is missing.

An example

```
<InstdAmt>0</InstdAmt>
```

Error message: Error cvc-complex-type.4: Attribute 'Ccy' must appear on element 'InstdAmt'.

How to fix: The reason for this error can be found out by examining the definition of *InstdAmt* from the schema and fixing the '*InstdAmt*' to be valid against the definition. In this example the attribute 'Ccy' must be given for '*InstdAmt*':

```
<InstdAmt Ccy="EUR">0</InstdAmt>
```
