

Notice! This page describes the *nature of the error* using a hypothetical example and not the erroneous data of the input test file. You should however be able to apply this information to your error case.



General description of the error:

The format of the error message: cvc-fractionDigits-valid: Value "{0}" has {1} fraction digits, but the number of fraction digits has been limited to {2}.

Possible causes for this error:

- Element value has too many digits in the fraction part.

An example

```
<InstdAmt Ccy="CCY">3.141592222222</InstdAmt>
```

Error message: Error cvc-fractionDigits-valid: Value '3.141592222222' has 13 fraction digits, but the number of fraction digits has been limited to 5.

How to fix: This issue can be fixed by removing the extra digits from the value.

```
<InstdAmt Ccy="CCY">3.14159</InstdAmt>
```
