

Notice! This page describes the *nature of the error* using a hypothetical example and not the erroneous data of the input test file. You should however be able to apply this information to your error case.



## General description of the error:

**The format of the error message:** cvc-totalDigits-valid: Value "{0}" has {1} total digits, but the number of total digits has been limited to {2}.

**Error description in schema standard:** <http://www.w3.org/TR/2006/WD-xmlschema11-2-20060217/datatypes.html#cvc-totalDigits-valid>

**Possible causes for this error:**

- Element value has too many digits.

## An example

```
<XchgRateInf>  
  <XchgRate>11113.1415926535</XchgRate>  
</XchgRateInf>
```

**Error message:** *Error cvc-totalDigits-valid: Value '11113.1415926535' has 15 total digits, but the number of total digits has been limited to 11.*

**How to fix:** This issue can be fixed by limiting the number of digits to 11.

```
<XchgRateInf>  
  <XchgRate>11113.141592</XchgRate>  
</XchgRateInf>
```
