



Notice! This page describes the *nature of the error* using a hypothetical example and not the erroneous data of the input test file. You should however be able to apply this information to your error case.

Error description:

The value of an element is longer than allowed.

Example:

```
95: <InstdAmt Ccy="EUR">1000000000000000000</InstdAmt>
```

ERROR (1837): *Element 'InstdAmt': [facet 'totalDigits'] The value '1000000000000000000' has more digits than are allowed ('18').*

This particular error can be fixed by giving a value which has less digits - maximum of 18.

Explanation of the error message given by the validator:

"Element 'X': [facet '**totalDigits**'] The value '**XX**' has more digits than allowed ('Y')."

Value **XX** of element X is erroneous because it contains more digits than allowed, which is Y.
