



## Description of the method

<b>Description:</b>	equalsIgnoreCase method compares string value to another string given as a parameter. The method returns true if the strings have same length and the corresponding characters in the strings are equal ignoring case.
<b>Available for:</b>	string
<b>Parameters:</b>	string
<b>Return type:</b>	boolean

### Example

<b>Context:</b>	HeaderType1
<b>OCL:</b>	self.Id.equalsIgnoreCase('idcontent')
<b>Description:</b>	The example rule executes

The XML snippet below would pass this check, the character content is equal to "idcontent" when case is ignored.

```
<Id>IdContent</Id>
```

The other snippet below however would not pass this check as the string is different length and the character content is not equal to "idcontent".

```
<Id>Content</Id>
```
