



## Description of the method

<b>Description:</b>	This method returns the character located at the String's specified index. The string indexes start from zero.
<b>Available for:</b>	string
<b>Parameters:</b>	int
<b>Return type:</b>	char

## Example

<b>Context:</b>	TransactionType1
<b>OCL:</b>	self.Id.charAt(1) = "A"
<b>Description:</b>	Example rule expects the position 1 (the second character in string) to contain "A".

The XML snippets below would pass this check.

```
<Id>aAa</Id>
```

```
<Id>a</Id>
```

It is worth noting that when the character does not exist in the defined position, expression is not ran.

The other snippet below however would not pass this check.

```
<Id>AaA</Id>
```
