



## Description of the method

<b>Description:</b>	.compareToIgnoreCase() compares the alphabetical order of two strings. Method returns a negative integer, zero, or a positive integer depending on whether the string is greater than, equal to, or less than this String, ignoring case considerations.
<b>Available for:</b>	string
<b>Parameters:</b>	string
<b>Return type:</b>	int

## Example

<b>Context:</b>	TransactionType1
<b>OCL:</b>	self.Id.compareToIgnoreCase("aaaa") = 0
<b>Description:</b>	Example rule expects the value of Id to contain characters "aaaa", ignoring case considerations.

The XML snippet below would pass this check.

```
<Id>AAAA</Id>
```

The other snippet below however would not pass this check.

```
<Id>Id Content</Id>
```
